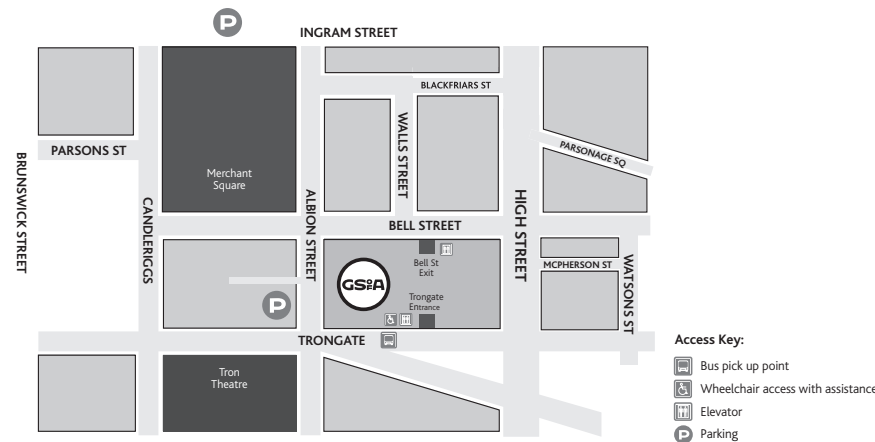

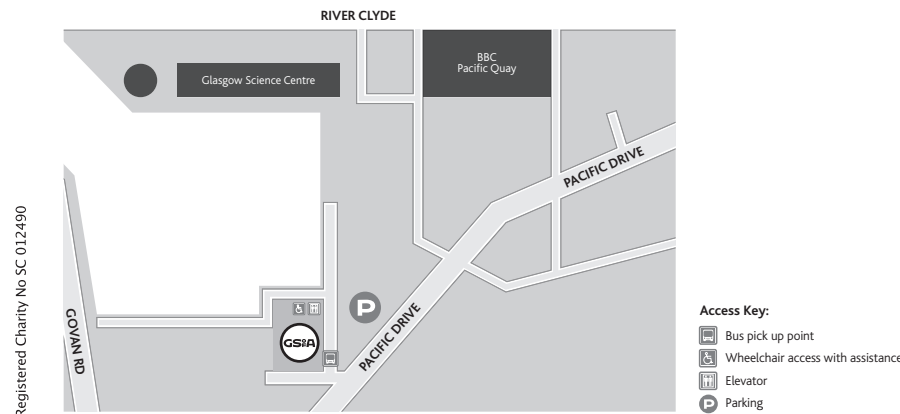

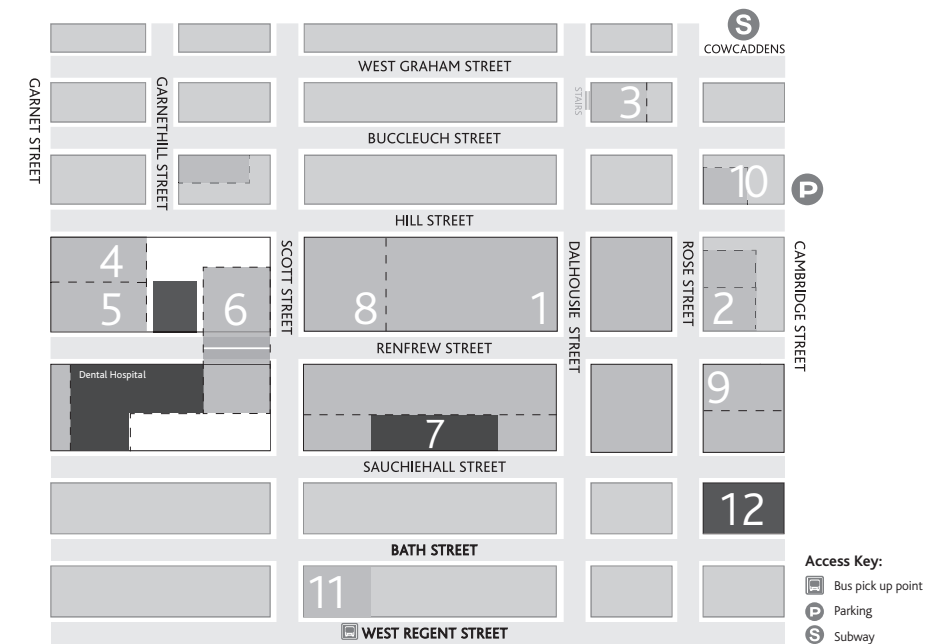
STUDIO VISITS
