

Scotland's Housing Expo

This study will undertake Building Performance Evaluation of 4 house types at the Scottish Housing Expo site. The Expo took place in Inverness throughout August 2010 and showcased innovative, sustainable housing and placemaking to an audience of over 33,000 visitors.

This study will seek to quantify the as-built performance, and relative energy and environmental performance of the house types in relation to different occupancies.

It will provide data about the ability of the houses to accommodate different patterns of use that likely to be experienced in real world conditions and it will provide insights into the scale of variation that different regimes may produce.
