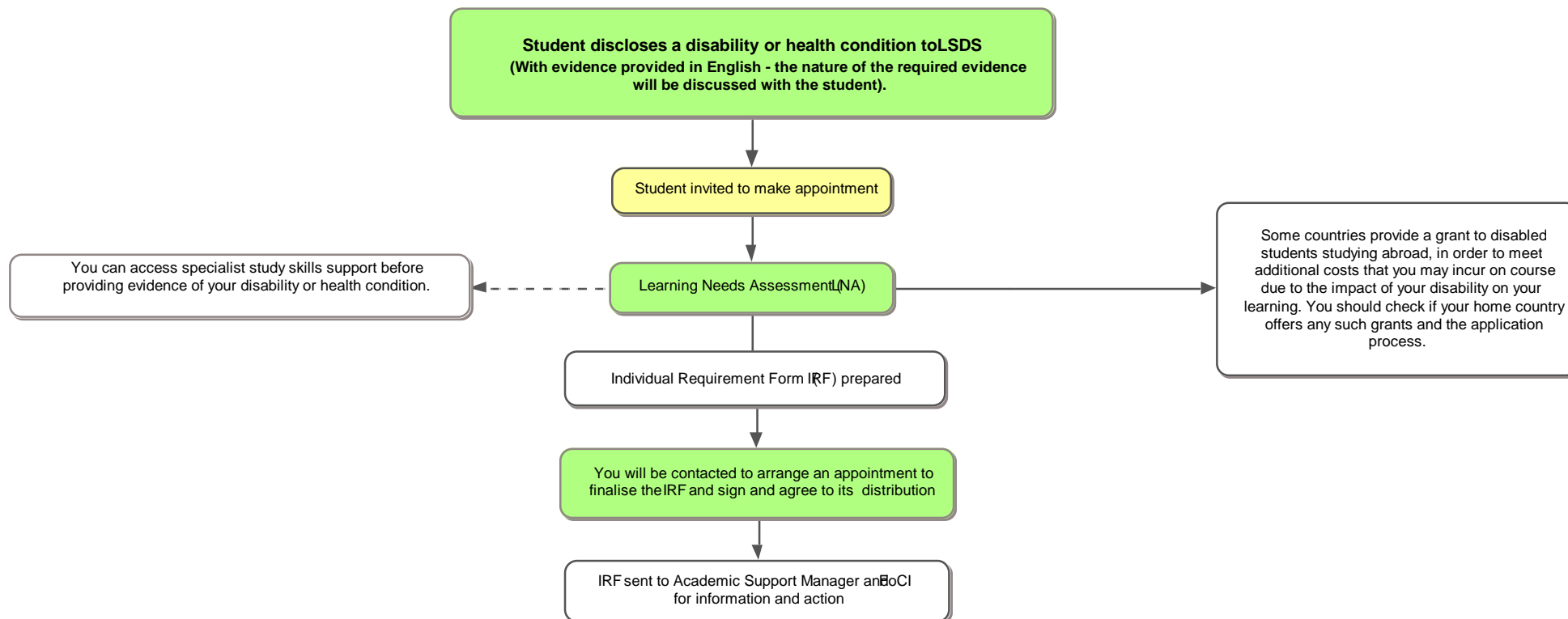


Disclosing Disability Related Learning Needs - Information for EU and International Students Learning Support and Development Service (LSDS)



Ongoing Support

Learning support is not mandatory and it is your responsibility to make and to keep appointments.

What is a Learning Needs Assessment? (LNA)

This is when you meet with either a LSDS tutor or the Disability Support Adviser to discuss your learning needs in the context of your course and identify strategies to support your learning. This may include specialist study skills support, or use of assistive technology.

Recommendations from this assessment will be used to prepare your IRF.

What is an Individual Requirement Form? (IRF)

An IRF lets your tutors know that you have particular disability related requirements, and outlines reasonable adjustments that tutors can make to the learning and teaching environment to support your learning.

The IRF also invites you to engage with LSDS.

Timescale

Depends on your circumstances, engagement and availability. Where evidence has been provided and a LNA has taken place, your IRF will be ready to email to relevant departments within a maximum of 20 working days.
