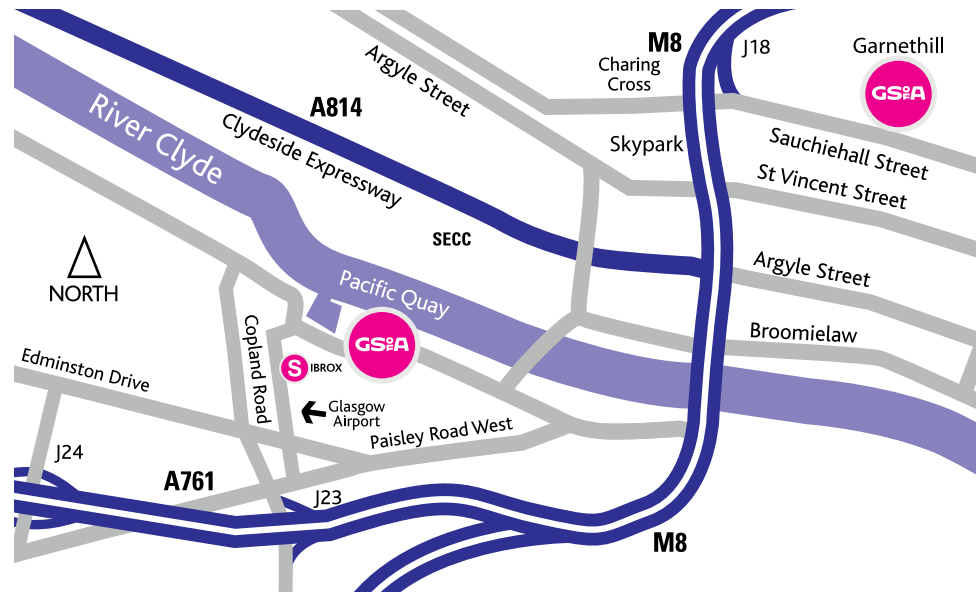


HOW DO I GET TO THE DIGITAL DESIGN STUDIO?

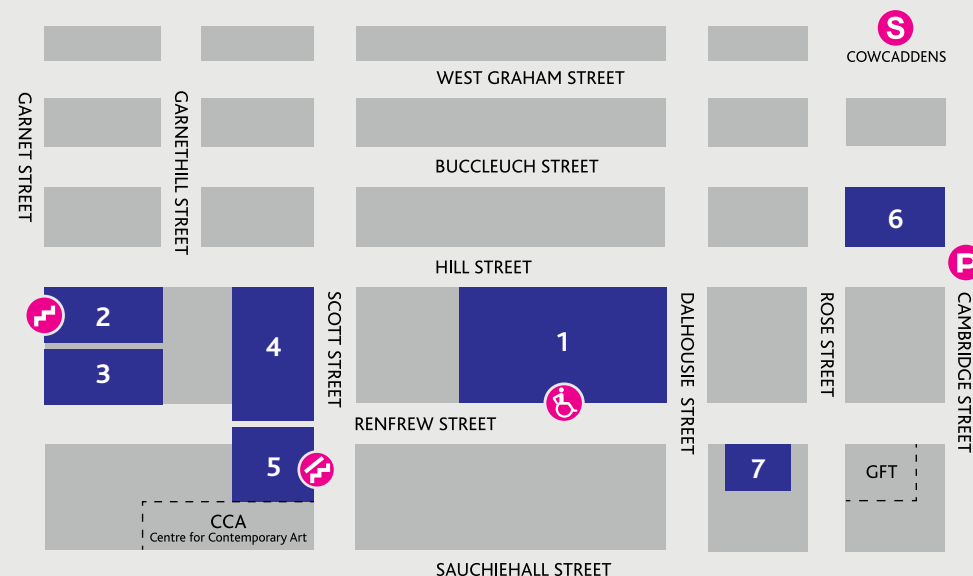
Should you require transport to visit the Digital Design Studio at Pacific Quay please meet at the Information Desk in the Reid Building at the following times and this will be arranged for you:
